During his time working for the Wiltshire Music Service, he taught pupils of all abilities from beginner to grade 8 and beyond, from both primary and secondary schools across the south of the county. Matthew is experienced in teaching jazz and classical styles and also in delivering First Access whole class projects with brass and recorder.

Matthew has performed with orchestras, jazz ensembles, shows and wind bands both as a player and a conductor and is currently the leader of the Salisbury Area Young Musician's Intermediate Wind Band.
